On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday; June 11, 12, and 13; from 09:30 AM until 12:00 Noon, Station 1, of the York County Department of Fire and Life Safety will be on site checking fire alarms and installing batteries where requested. This year the York County Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) will accompany the fire fighters and EMTs and offer an in-home safety check where requested.

THIS PROGRAM IS TOTALLY VOLUNTARY BUT STRONGLY ENCOURAGED.

A map of the Rainbrook Villas community is on the reverse page. The map shows the three color-coded sections, one for each day, where the Fire Fighters, EMTs and CERT members will be going to homes that have requested assistance with their fire alarms, batteries, and in-home safety checks.

We only have them for three mornings, so let's be prepared for them by having the required, new batteries on-hand and ready for each alarm.
